ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Adhere to Safety Procedures including, but not limited to Lock Out Tag Out, Power Industrial Truck, Scissor Lift, Harness/Fall Protection, etc.
- Ensure building and grounds are clean and in acceptable condition.
- Performs preventative maintenance procedures on all equipment that is assigned by the maintenance supervisor.
- Assist other areas of the plant when major problems occur.
- Completes all assigned tasks scheduled and unscheduled work as directed by supervisor.
- Goal oriented and possess root cause analysis skills.
- Considerable knowledge of the methods, materials, tools, and practices used in general building maintenance.
- Conducts preoperational inspection and handles maintenance concerns of Production Supervisors to make sure operation begins as scheduled.
- Processes maintenance downtime reports for plant management.
