- Provide maintenance and repair support for all manufacturing and auxiliary equipment
- Perform preventative maintenance on electrical components for all equipment
- Perform electrical troubleshooting and repair on various equipment and building maintenance
- Performing electrical maintenance and other duties
- Perform electrical repairs and regular maintenance
- Perform installation, maintenance and repairs on manufacturing equipment
- Trouble shooting and resolving manufacturing equipment issues
- Maintaining industrial manufacturing equipment and processes
- Performing both electrical and mechanical work used in manufacturing production processes
- Troubleshooting electrical/electronic industrial plant equipment
- Conducts preoperational inspection and handles maintenance concerns of Production Supervisors to make sure operation begins as scheduled.
