

Position: Offal Organ Processing Technician, Beef Processing Facility

**Shift: First** 8:00am – 4:30 pm **Department: Harvest / Fabrication**

**Objective:** The Offal Technician position at our Beef Processing Facility assists in operating, cleaning and adjusting equipment, prevent spills and removal of bi-product trailers from offal area and to service, maintain, and adjust production processing equipment, machinery, and plant facilities to maximize production up time. Responsibility also includes working with on-site managers, ensuring offal trailers are picked up on time through normal DOT scheduling practices and procedures. Ensure trailer is loaded, and areas cleaned throughout.

## ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Operates jockey truck transferring trailers to and from the processing area.
- Ensures that trailers are processed in the order designated by management.
- Ensures that Quality is updated, and all policies followed. Keeping the yard organized and in order.
- Performs daily pre-op inspection of vehicle and post-op cleaning.
- Check all pumps, screens fans, blood tanks and lung tanks.
- Keep screws, belts, dumper and screens clean of debris and build up.
- Pump down blood room to tanks in offal and onto trucks.
- Properly load trucks.
- Drive trucks in and out of loading / unloading area and inspect for good working order.
- Work with Maintenance dept. as needed to perform preventative maintenance as needed.
- Candidate will be able to operate a forklift, trucks, and Jack lift.
- Cover loads prior to removal from work area.
- Ensure offal area is kept clean inside and out. Clean and wash down equipment, pit, walls and floors as needed
- Ensure all trailer tracking and process monitoring paperwork is filled out correctly daily

- Previous experience in Harvest or Fabrication, specifically handling Offal.
- Ability to follow instructions and work independently or as part of a team
- Strong attention to detail and time management skills
- Previous Experience with Forklifts, Jack Lift, and Truck Loading / Unloading.
